FIRST AMENDMENT TO

This FIRST AMENDMENT (**Amendment**) to that certain Interlocal Agreement (**Interlocal Agreement**) effective on June 1, 2020 and entered into by and between the University of Washington and its branch campus, University of Washington Tacoma, a public institution of higher education and an agency of the state of Washington, (**UW-T**), by and through the Center for Urban Waters’ Puget Sound Institute (**Institute**), and the City of Tacoma (**City**), is entered into by and between the Institute and the City and shall be **effective on June 1, 2022**.

WHEREAS the Institute and the City entered into the Interlocal Agreement pursuant to chapter 39.34 RCW for the purpose described therein, and

WHEREAS Article VI, sections “a” and “c” of the Interlocal Agreement provide that the Institute and City may by written agreement extend the initial term, and

WHEREAS the Institute and the City desire to extend the term of the Interlocal Agreement for two-years (Extension Term) upon the same terms and conditions,

NOW THEREFORE, the Institute and the City mutually agree to enter into this Amendment for the purposes set forth herein, as follows;


Section 1. Article VI of the Interlocal Agreement is hereby amended by the insertion of new subsection “h” following subsection “g”, and reading as follows:


- h. The Institute and the City mutually agree that the Initial Term of this Agreement is extended for two-years and shall remain in effect until May 30, 2024.


Section 2. All other terms and conditions of the Interlocal Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.



RESOLUTION NO. 40988

1 A RESOLUTION relating to wastewater; authorizing the execution of an
 2 amendment to the Interlocal Agreement ("Agreement") with the University of
 3 Washington Tacoma Puget Sound Institute ("UWT"), to extend the
 4 Agreement for two additional years, to continue a sustainable program of
 work at UWT, to address regional modeling needs, stakeholder engagement,
 and model applications, through May 30, 2024.

5 WHEREAS the City has a need to execute an amendment to the Interlocal
 6 Agreement ("Agreement") with the University of Washington Tacoma Puget Sound
 7 Institute ("UWT"), and

 9 WHEREAS nutrient dynamics in the Puget Sound may be playing a part in
 10 lower dissolved oxygen levels in parts of the Puget Sound, and it is necessary to
 11 understand these nutrient dynamics in order to develop strategies that will best
 12 protect and enhance the health of Puget Sound, and

13
 14 WHEREAS UWT is uniquely qualified to investigate nutrient dynamics and
 15 model scenarios that will provide insights into the effects of various sources of
 16 nutrients on dissolved oxygen levels in the Puget Sound, and UWT has the
 17 expertise to run and refine the Salish Sea model, and

18
 19 WHEREAS the objective of this Agreement is to utilize the established
 20 modeling center and sustainable program of work at UWT, as well as the
 21 expertise of UWT to identify effective strategies for protecting the Puget Sound,
 22 and will inform discharge permits, stormwater mitigation strategies and other
 23 efforts that manage nutrient inputs to the Puget Sound, and

 25 WHEREAS this Agreement will enable the City, participating agencies,
 26 government and non-government stakeholders and collaborators to have



1 increased model access, and to support confidence in model results and capacity
2 to undertake runs of interest in a timely fashion; Now, Therefore,

3 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TACOMA:

4 Section 1. That the proper officers of the City are hereby authorized to
5 amend the Interlocal Agreement ("Agreement") with the University of Washington
6 Tacoma Puget Sound Institute ("UWT"), to extend the Agreement for two additional
7 years, to continue a sustainable program of work at UWT to address regional
8 modeling needs, stakeholder engagement, and model applications through May 30,
9 2024, as more specifically set forth in the document on file in the office of the City
10 Clerk.

13 Section 2. That the City Manager, or designee, is hereby directed to
14 negotiate and execute an agreement with UWT, outlining the scope of work and
15 deliverables outlined in Section 1.
