City Manager's Office

- 6:02pm Ted Richardson stated that CPAC interviews will occur on November 10, that eight applicants will be interviewing for three positions.
- CPAC members will be receiving a survey from the City Manager's Office to review Chief Moore's first year as Police Chief.

Tacoma Police Department

- 6:04pm Captain Aguirre shared data through August 2022 on TPD demographics by position on age, ethnicity, race, and sex. The department is currently 17% female and is engaged in the nationwide 30x 30 campaign with the goal of TPD being 30% female by 2030.
 - Social media recruitment and a new recruited has really helped in recruiting new officers.
 - This data is also useful for tracking possible retirements to predict open positions and filling and promoting to fill higher roles.
- 6:18pm TPD makes multiple attempts before impounding a vehicle. If they are unable to locate the owner it may be impounded though.
