- TPD legal determined TPD has jurisdiction over crimes committed in NWIPC

Ongoing

- Getting Blue Cards (incident cards) translated into multiple languages and officers trained to explain information using professional interpreters
 - Media and Communication working on translation and QR codes
- Distributing reporting crimes cards in multiple languages
 - English, Spanish, Vietnamese, Cambodian, Russian, Korean; asked for Arabic and Amharic
- Outreach and reporting crimes cards into NWIPC
 - Who is new TPD NWIPC liaison?
- Trauma Informed Policing training proposal wrt immigrants and refugees
 - ▶ Talking with TPD & State Criminal Justice Training Commission
- Anti-hate campaign: Be Kind Tacoma. No Room for Hate
 - Waiting to hear from Media and Communication
