5	must comply with Section 2.3 of the Tacoma City Charter, and

7 8	follows: five members, one from each City Council district, selected by lot by the
9	Pierce County Auditor from registered City of Tacoma voters eligible to vote at
10	the time of selection; and two members who are residents of the City of Tacoma,
11	to be appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the City Council, one with
12	experience in human resource management and the other with experience in the
13 14	legal profession, and
15	WHEREAS two vacancies exist on the Commission, and
16	WHEREAS, pursuant to City Charter Section 2.3, the Mayor has nominated
17	Greg Amann to serve on the Commission for the position with legal profession
18	experience, for a term expiring on September 30, 2024, and the Pierce County
19 20	Auditor has selected by lottery, Sara Liu, for the District No. 2 position, for a term
21	expiring on September 30, 2025; Now, Therefore,
