Personal fireworks use is prohibited in Tacoma. Learn more about fireworks safety.

I hope all of you are having a restful Fourth of July weekend! I wanted to take time to send you some information about the Fireworks Ban here in the City of Tacoma. As you may know, fireworks are prohibited in the City. Firework usage can be reported through a new online service this year at [FireworksReport.com](https://www.fireworksreport.com).

I'm encouraging everyone to use the online service for reporting fireworks to help reduce the number of non-emergency calls being received by South Sound 911. You can also report by calling the non-emergency police number at (253) 287-4455. For emergencies, as always, call 911.

Fireworks have been prohibited in Tacoma since 1992 due to fire and injury risks. If you are using fireworks in the city, it can result in a \$513 fine. For more information: [City of Tacoma - Fireworks](https://www.cityoftacoma.org/fireworks).
