TMC Emergency LCR 3.2 (o) RELEASE OF THE ACCUSED

The court adopts the following bail schedule pursuant to CrRLJ 3.2(b)(7) and CrRLJ 3.2(o): A Defendant who is detained in jail after the initial arrest for a misdemeanor or gross misdemeanor shall be released upon posting bail in the amount of \$500 for a misdemeanor and \$1000 for a gross misdemeanor, except for the following offenses:

- 1. Domestic Violence Offenses: Defendants shall be held in non-bailable status pending hearing the next court day following booking for any crime alleging domestic violence under RCW 10.99.020(5) or applicable local ordinance.
- 2. Other Non-Bailable Offenses Pending First Court Appearance by Defendant: Defendants shall be held in non-bailable status pending hearing the next court day following booking for these crimes:
- a. Assault in the Fourth Degree (RCW 9A.36.041)
- b. Harassment (RCW 9A.46.020)
- c. Violation of Anti-Harassment Order (RCW 9A.46.040)
- d. Stalking (RCW 9A.46.110)
- e. Communicating with a Minor for Immoral Purposes (RCW 9.68A.090)

[That pursuant to GR 7 (c) & (f)(2) the proposed emergency rule shall become effective for a period of 90 days immediately following filing with the state Administrative Office of the Courts.]
