## **Tacoma Mall Shooting**

Tacoma, Wash. –On Friday, November 26<sup>th</sup>, 2021, two off-duty officers worked a Holiday special emphasis inside the Tacoma Mall. At around 7:00 pm, those officers heard what they believed to be several gunshots. The uniformed Officers notified South Sound 911 that a gun was being fired from inside the Mall and ran toward the shooting. Officers quickly identified one male victim and assisted with medical aid. The Tacoma Fire Department responded and transported the victim to a local area hospital.

After interviewing witnesses at the scene, detectives believe that this isolated incident grew out of an argument between two groups of people and was not an active shooter event.

Detectives are reviewing videos in this active investigation. At this time, there is no one in custody, and the victim is in stable condition.

The Tacoma Police Department would like to thank the 87 officers from eight local agencies that responded to assist with this incident.
