

Proclamation of Emergency Second Amended Rule No. 1

 WHEREAS, COVID-19 (Novel Coronavirus), is a respiratory disease that can result in serious illness or death and is caused by a virus easily spread from person to person; and WHEREAS on March 13, 2020 the City Manager and the Mayor of Tacoma pursuant to Chapter 1.10 of the Tacoma Municipal Code and Chapter 38.52 of the Revised Code of Washington ("RCW") proclaimed that an emergency exists caused by the COVID-19 ("Proclamation") in the City of Tacoma; and WHEREAS pursuant to the Proclamation the Mayor is authorized to issue rules reasonably related to the protection of life provided, such rules must be confirmed at the earliest practicable time by the City Council; and WHEREAS the Mayor issued Amended Rule No. 1 that was confirmed by the Council on March 17, 2020, setting the maximum occupancy of the Council Chambers, excluding City Council and City staff, to ten (10) persons; and WHEREAS the Mayor now desires to increase the maximum occupancy of the Council Chambers to 50% capacity (72 persons) to continue to allow for social distancing of members of the public; and WHEREAS to protect the health and safety of the public, the City will follow this guidance by limiting the occupancy of the City Council Chambers during publi- meetings; Now, Therefore, BE IT ORDERED BY THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF TACOMA: Effective August 10, 2021, the maximum occupancy of the City Council Chambers excluding the City Council and city staff, shall be 50% capacity (72 persons) to allow for social distancing while still allowing the community to attend open publi- meetings. This Second Amended Rule No. 1 shall replace Amended Rule No. 1 an shall remain in effect until the Proclamation of Emergency has been terminated. Dated August 3, 2021
