
### **Working Group Engagement Plan**

#### Goals

- Co-create the Neighborhood Planning process, strategies, and actions in collaboration with residents
- Recruit working groups that are reflective of diverse experiences and identities
- Generate short- and long-term goals/actions for specific topic areas
- Identify actionable and feasible strategies with the support of subject-matter experts
- Integrate working group ideas directly into the McKinley Hill Action Plan
- Begin implementation of key actions with the support of working groups

### **Working Group Focus Areas**

- Arts and Identity
- Walkability and Traffic Calming
- Open Space, Recreation, and Environment
- Business District Vitality
- Housing and Affordability
- Capacity-Building, Grant-Writing, and Implementation



#### Structure

Working groups will be small groups of 5-10 residents/key stakeholders, including members of the steering group. Roles include:

- Chair: A member of the community to be chosen/volunteer to lead the group
- Steering group liaison: Reports back to steering group (can also be the chair)
- **Subject-matter expert(s):** Partners who will work with the group to generate and assess strategies and actions
- **NPP liaison:** Neighborhood Planning staff; support meeting scheduling, tech, note-taking, and agendas, and tracking actions

## Working group commitment:

- Monthly/bi-monthly meetings (each group to determine as needed)
- From spring 2022 through spring 2023 potential ongoing work after the life of the plan
