

### Passive Open Space


- Natural "wild" areas

- Program began in 2014





- ☐ Clean up costs in 2021 almost \$18,000
- Costs almost cut in half during the purple bag pilot
- □ Numerous unsheltered persons connected with services in 2021& 2022

### M Slope Ideas

- Volunteer restoration program on flat areas
- Work with tribe to develop a joint long-term restoration plan
- Develop a foraging trail along E. N St and any new paths/walkways that are installed to replace the steps (there is currently no plan to replace the steps).
- Install signage identifying the significance of certain plants to the tribe in both English and Lushootseed.
