INITIAL PRIORITIZATION: May – July

- ✓ May 23 SG meeting (today): Discuss project tasks for implementation
- ✓ June 27 SG meeting: Continue discussion and determine next steps (based on **survey**)
- Outreach Events: Seek feedback from neighbors on specific topics
- (Tentative) Launch short-term project groups based on initial priorities

SHARE DRAFT PROJECT TASKS: August – September

- Large Public Event: Share DRAFT list of priorities with neighbors for feedback
 - Promote event through targeted outreach, online engagement, mailers, etc.
 - Recruit members for Working Groups
- (Tentative) Launch long-term project groups based on the priorities from public feedback

DRAFT PLAN: Fall 2022

- Develop draft McKinley Neighborhood Plan
- ✓ Fall Steering Group meetings: Review draft plan
- Ongoing Working Group meetings

VERIFICATION: Fall 2022/Winter 2023
