TACOMA, Wash. – On March 5, 2020 at 10:39 p.m., Tacoma Police Officers responded to assist Puyallup Police who were in pursuit of a domestic violence suspect that had entered Tacoma City limits. The pursuit ended in the area of East 64th and Portland Avenue at 10:40 p.m. Shots were fired by a Puyallup Officer. No police officers were injured. The 45-year-old white male suspect was transported to a local hospital for non-life-threatening injuries. No Tacoma Police Officers were involved in the shooting.

The Tacoma Police Department will be conducting an independent investigation of the shooting. Detectives and Forensic Specialists responded to the scene. The investigation is active and ongoing.
