At approximately 0100 hours on January 5, 2020 Tacoma Police responded to a house in the 3800 block of N. 21st Street. A resident had called 911 to report that someone had been shot. Upon arrival, officers located a victim and called for medical aid. The Tacoma Fire Department transported the victim to a local hospital in critical condition. The victim later died of his injuries.

The victim was a 25 year old white male.

Tacoma Police Detectives determined through subsequent investigation that the shooting incident was a homicide.

On the evening of January 8, 2020, Detectives served two search warrants related to the investigation. Three suspects were arrested and booked into the Pierce County Jail for Second Degree Murder and First Degree Manslaughter.

The investigation is still active and ongoing.
