Homicide Investigation

Tacoma, Wash. – On March 14, just after 8:30 a.m., South Sound 911 received a call from a resident in the 4400 block of S. 49th St. reporting that their female neighbor was on their front porch with a gunshot wound saying her husband had shot her.

Officers responded to the residence where the incident had occurred and located an unresponsive male inside with gunshot wounds. Life saving measures were started and medical aid called for. No one else was in the residence or believed to be involved.

The 43-year-old female was transported to a local hospital with non-life threatening injuries.

The 55-year-old male was transported to a local hospital with life threatening injuries.

Detectives and crime scene technicians responded to the scene.

On March 15, the 55-year-old male died at the hospital from his injuries.

This incident is now being investigated as a homicide.
