Arrest Made In Homicide Investigation

Tacoma, Wash. — On September 21, 2020, just after 6:30 p.m. South Sound 911 received reports of a shooting in the 1300 block of S. 23 St. Upon arrival officers found one victim on the ground. Life saving measures were started and the victim was transported to a local hospital.

The victim, identified by the Pierce County Medical Examiner's Office as 19-year-old Dylan Coolidge, later died from his injuries.

Detectives identified a 15-year-old male suspect in the homicide and a Murder 1st Degree warrant was issued through the Pierce County Superior Courts on September 25.

On November 28, 2020, the 15-year-old male suspect was contacted and placed under arrest by Pierce County Sheriff Deputies at 114th and Pacific Avenue. The suspect was later booked into jail for the Murder 1st degree warrant and other charges.
