

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

- Grant opportunities

### E 34TH ST DECK REPAIR & SEISMC RETROFIT






Project Detail: This project includes seismic repairs to the bridge support, bridge deck, streetlighting, and pedestrian separation.

Funding: Federal Bridge Grant \$7,220,000; Streets Initiative \$1,000,000

### ••• SHERIDAN AVE COMPLETE STR





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Project Detail: This project includes up to 3 phases on Sheridan Avenue between 56th and 72<sup>nd</sup> Streets. Phase 1 is generally funded and includes roadway reconstruction and complete streets accommodations.

Funding: Streets Initiative \$2,394,332; Real Estate Excise Tax \$400,000; Transportation Improvement Board Grant \$3,560,000; Unidentified City \$1,865,000

# PEDESTRIAN ACCESSIBILITY \*\*\* IMPROVEMENTS







#### Project Detail:

This project will construct curb ramps and short sections of missing link sidewalks to support accessibility for all users.

#### Funding:

HUD Community Development Fund \$3,000,000; Streets Initiative \$100,000

#### Project Detail:


This project will rehabilitate roadway, add bike facilities, improve ADA access, and upgrade stormwater system.

#### Funding:

Streets Initiative Fund \$6.015M; Transportation Improvement Board Grant \$4M; REET \$3.4M; Unidentified Grant \$7M


