# TACOMA: RULES OF ROAD

Attention, Tacoma: Tips to Know Before You Scoot!

Hey, Tacoma! Razor Share e-scooters are a safe, affordable, and convenient way to get you where you need to go. While riding our scooters, follow all City and State laws to make things safer for both yourself and those around you. So, before you hop on your next Razor scooter, the City of Tacoma has asked that we share their rules of the road with you.

# **HOW TO REGISTER**

- Download the "Razor Share" app on your smartphone.
- Submit a form of ID proving that you are at least 18 years old.
- Swipe through our educational modules to learn how to ride our scooters responsibly.
- Use the map in the Razor Share app to find the closest scooter to you.
- Scan the QR code in the middle of the handlebars and begin your ride!

## WHERE TO RIDE IN TACOMA

- You can ride on sidewalks and paved trails, but you must yield to pedestrians.
- You can ride in bike lanes and cycle tracks.
- You can ride on all streets with speed limits of 25 mph or less.
- You cannot ride on streets with speed limits greater than 25 mph, unless you are riding in a bicycle facility.
- You can ride within parks on roads, sidewalks, paths, or trails, unless signs expressly prohibit scooter riding.

### PARK RESPONSIBLY

Leave scooters parked in an upright position in the "furniture zone" of the sidewalk. Make sure to leave five (5) feet clearance for pedestrian travel, and seven (7) feet clearance along arterials, in mixed use centers, and in downtown. Also, make sure that you don't block access to transit, ADA parking, curb ramps, pedestrian push buttons, loading zones, street or park furniture, building entryways, or driveways.

### **PARKING CORRALS**

Please use designated parking areas where available. In some popular pedestrian destinations, parking zones will be required. Parking zones are demarcated with a green and white "P" in the Razor Share app.

# **USE A HELMET**

Please use a helmet while scooting.
