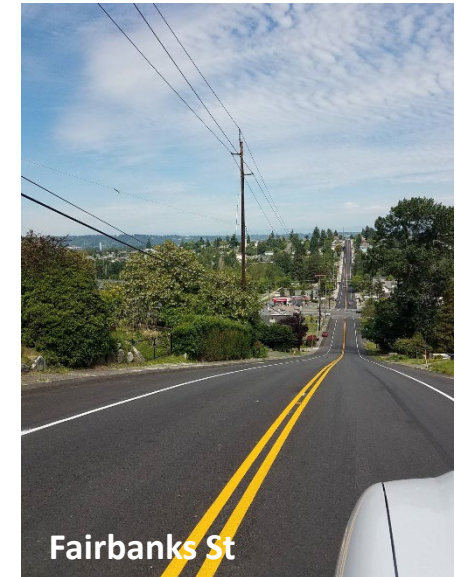

 - Most Streets Initiatives



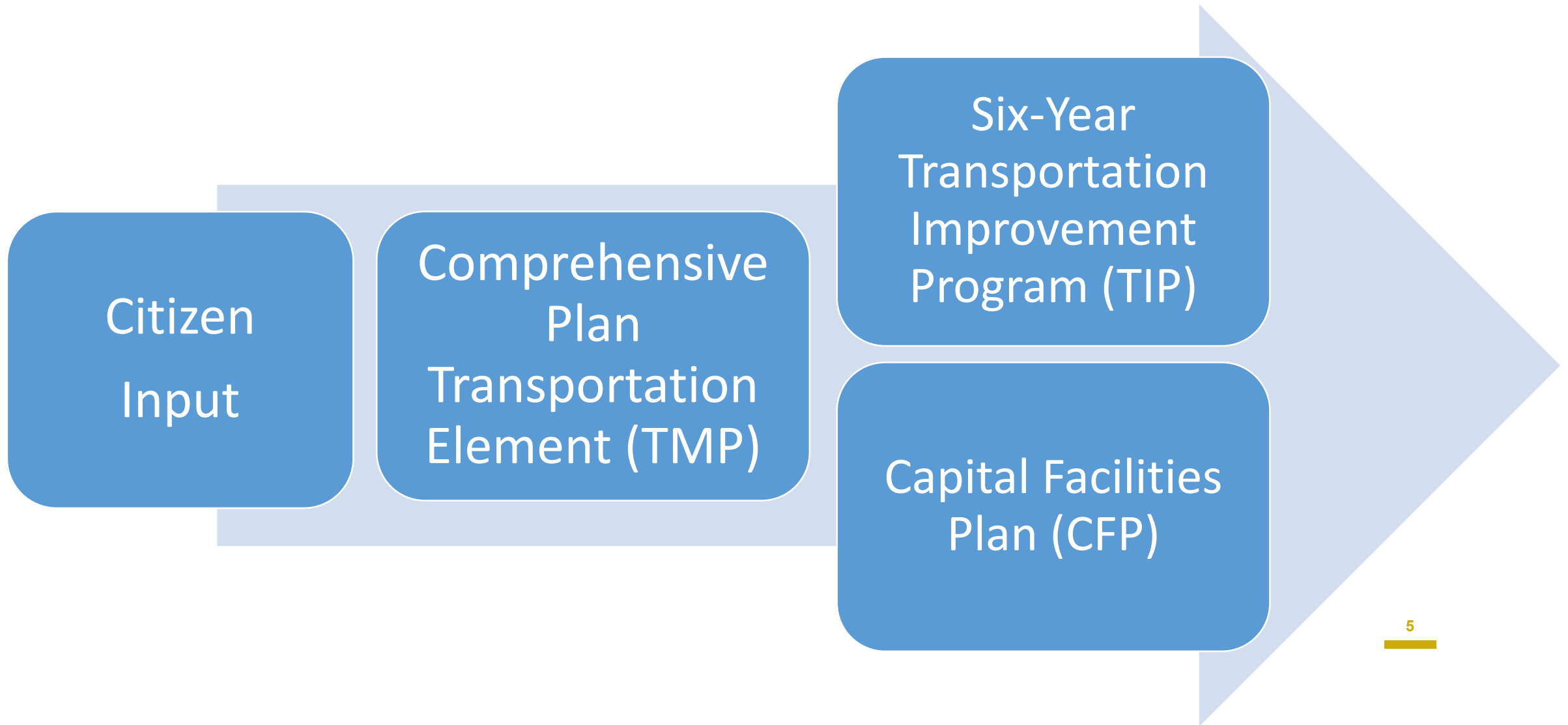

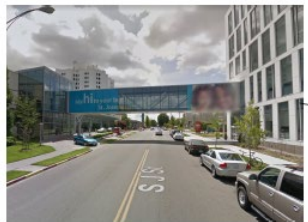

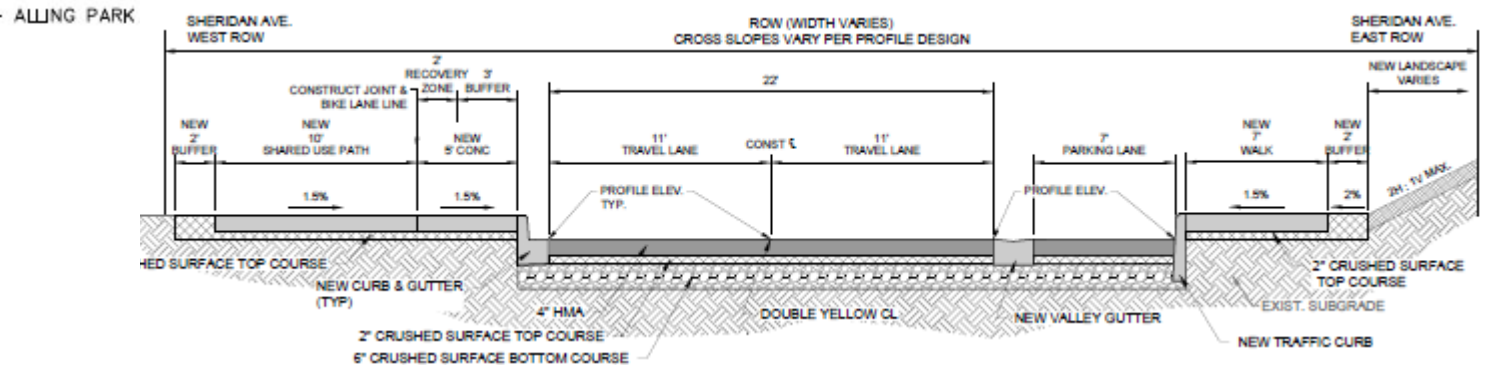
