## **QUESTIONS and ANSWERS**

This information IS NOT considered an addendum. Respondents should consider this information when submitting their proposals.

Question 1: The previous call for bid had a cap on the bond amount of 600K +-. Equal

to the possible amount of work in a given year. I would request the city does the same with this request. Tying up \$2.7M in bonding for possibly very little work in a single year can keep a contractor from participating in

this RFP.

**Answer 1:** As this is an on-call contract, payment and performance bonds will be

required at 25% of the total contract value (\$675,000). This is reflected in Section 13 of the bid document on Performance and Payment Bonds.
