QUESTIONS and ANSWERS

All interested parties had the opportunity to submit questions in writing by email to Doreen Klaaskate by 3:00 p.m., Pacific Time, November 19, 2020. The answers to the questions received are provided below and posted to the City's website at www.TacomaPurchasing.org: Navigate to *Current Contracting Opportunities / Services* and then click *Questions and Answers* for this Specification. This information IS NOT considered an addendum. Respondents should consider this information when submitting their proposals.

Question 1: What I was wondering is your specs for this project ask for 2 jobs that show the work history, is that for the company or can I use my experience for the company, the new company that I am with has never done this type of work. I understand that we need to remove the media and it is classified as a hazardous waste and the refill the odor control devices.

Answer 1: The current firm needs to provide documented proof of 2 jobs. The firm or company is bidding on the work, not the employee.

Question 2: Please provide an estimated schedule for each change-out.

Answer 2: There are four scrubbers that will need to be serviced once every one to three years.

Question 3: Will there be an opportunity for price adjustment annually, since this is a 5 year contract?

Answer 3: Price adjustments can be made when agreed upon by the City and the contractor.

Question 4: Could PCC request pictures and details for the 4th vessel at the Cleveland site?

Question 5: Would you be able to give drawings of each vessel so we can gauge access beyond what shows in the photos?

Question 6: Could we obtain pictures of overhead clearance so we can gauge appropriate equipment required to perform the work?

Question 7: What are the available work hours on-site?

Answer 7: Due to noise ordinances and crew working hours all work will need to be performed between 7:00 am -2:00 PM.

Question 8: Can fresh/Spent carbon be stored at each site for a short period of time, or is there a central location where materials can be stored for a short period of time?

Answer 8: The media can be stored on the site it was removed from and then picked up at the same as the rest of the other sites materials, if needed. But the city requests that material from the other sites is not relocated to a different site for storage purposes.

Question 9: Is there opportunity to view the individual sites prior to December 1st?

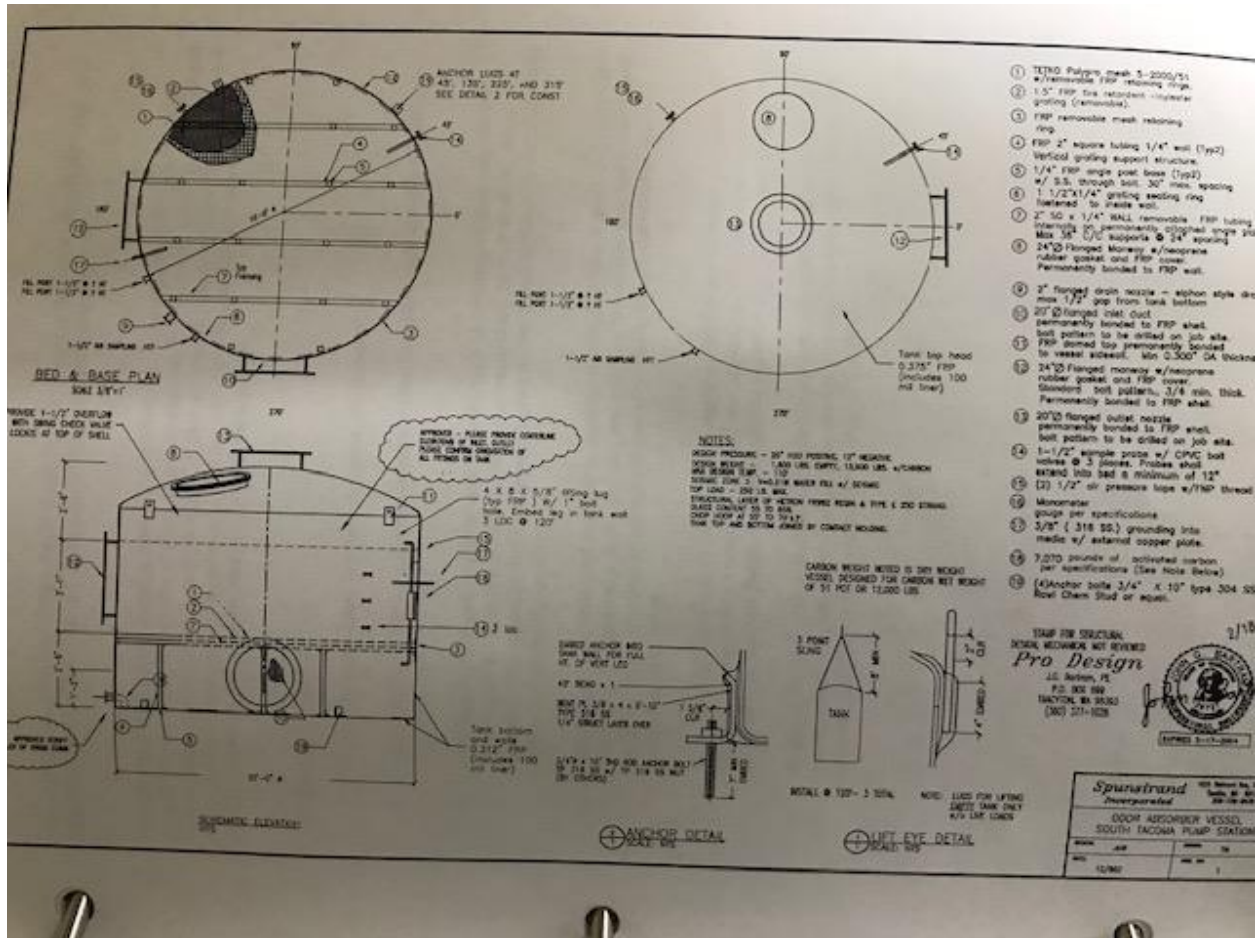
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
