Project Scope: This Contract provides for the improvement of the South 56th Street corridor by generally providing pavement resurfacing including asphalt grind and overlay as well as concrete panel replacement; upgrading curb ramps, driveways and sidewalks to meet Americans with Disabilities Act requirements; installing street lights and signal interconnect; upgrading existing traffic signal infrastructure; Sanitary Sewer replacement; striping removal and application; and installation of signage and other work, all in accordance with the attached Contract Plans, these Contract Provisions, and the Standard Specifications.

Estimate: \$5,850,320, **not including sales tax.**
