1. Will the City be granting a suspension for material procurement?

The City will follow the standard specification for project suspension provided in section 1-08.6, should it be deemed necessary.

2. Would you please clarify the mounting heights of the luminaire arms for poles #6 and #10, as the construction notes call out for both to be 30' mounting heights, whereby the traffic signal detail chart shows them both to be at 40'. What dimension will actually be required for both?

3. Also on plan sheet #sg-1, there looks to be service cabinet/pedestal symbol located at the intersection to supply power, but no indication of a construction note requirement – will one be required here, or is it existing?


