## **QUESTIONS and ANSWERS**

This information IS NOT considered an addendum. Respondents should consider this information when submitting their proposals.

- **Question 1:** Would the electrical connections be provided for the pedestrian and cyclist counting sensors.
- Answer 1: No electrical connections will be provided specifically for pedestrian and cyclist counting sensors
- Question 2: Does the City have GPS equipment available for contractor use?
- Answer 2: No, City does not have GPS equipment available.
- **Question 3:** Will contractor creating new GIS datasets for Medians and Traffic Islands, Clear Zone and Fixed Objects, and Sidewalks and Crosswalks or will the field investigations be appended to existing data?
- Answer 3: New GIS datasets will be created by the consultant/contractor.
- **Question 4:** Could the City expand on the cost estimate deliverable?
- Answer 4: Details regarding the cost estimate deliverable will be discussed after the selection of the consultant and is not required as a deliverable of the RFQ.
- Question 5: 30 working days for the entire project or to complete the field investigations?
- Answer 5: The estimated 30 working days is anticipated for the entire project; however, the scope, budget, and schedule will be part of the contract negotiation process.
