## I-5 / S 56th St. Interchange ADA Compliance RFB Specification No. PW21-0462F

Question 1: The specs say to maintain a 11' minimum access for traffic on ramps with grinding and removal & replacement. How can this spec be expected to be followed?

Answer 1: The 11-ft lane width is for work relating to the adjacent ped ramp/curb areas and does not apply to the stage of work when the pavement grinding/re-paving is occurring at a given on-/off-ramp location. That paving work would be governed by the Specs' closure allowances and WSDOT concurrence.
