




EXPLODED VIEW

HAND RAIL NOTES:

- 1. ALL HAND RAIL PARTS SHALL BE POWDER COATED PER SPECIFICATIONS PRIOR TO ON-SITE DELIVERY.
- CUTTING SHALL BE DONE BY SAWING OR MILLING AND ALL CUTS SHALL BE TRUE AND SMOOTH.
- HAND RAILS SHALL BE FIELD MEASURED, INSTALLED AND ADJUSTED IF NECESSARY AFTER INSTALLATION TO ENSURE A CONTINUOUS LINE AND GRADE.
- 4. CONTRACTOR TO PROVIDE TOLERANCES FOR HAND RAIL INSTALLATION PER THE SPECS.
- 5. SLEEVE CONNECTION FOR HAND RAIL SHALL BE LOCATED 12" MAX BEFORE EVERY BEND AT 20' MAX O.C.
