

Paul Swortz's term on the Police Officers' Pension/Disability Board will expire June 30, 2024.

Nomination forms were mailed April 25, 2024, to all LEOFF 1 retired members of the Police Department. Nomination forms must be postmarked by May 16, 2024.

Nominees must be willing to serve on the Board for a period of three (3) years. There are no term limits; therefore, Board members may serve consecutive terms if elected.

LEOFF 1 or LEOFF 2 active and retired members of the Police Department may be nominated to serve on the Board. Only LEOFF 1 active and retired members may nominate and vote in the election process.

Per Board policy, balloting will not be held in the event of only one nominee.

UPDATE as of 5/23/2024

The current Police Officers' Board nomination process closed as of May 16, 2024.

The Police Pension Office received a nomination form with six signatures nominating the current Board incumbent Paul Swortz, retired LEOFF 1 member. *(Five signatures are required for a valid nomination.)*

Per Board policy, balloting will not be held in the event of only one nominee. Therefore, no ballots will be mailed and Paul Swortz is declared elected for the three-year term beginning July 1, 2024 and ending June 30, 2027.
