Consent Agenda

Motion: Upon motion by Andy Cherullo seconded by Justin Angove, the Board of Administration accepted and approved the Administrative Consent Agenda to include the drafted minutes of the August 10, 2023, Retirement Board meeting.

Old Business

Investment Update

Chief Investment Officer Tim Atwill presented Wilshire's asset class market performance report for the 3rd quarter, laying the groundwork for TERS' investment results that will be presented at the November Board meeting. He then provided an update on the ongoing inquiry into potential alternative strategies for TERS' allocation to high yield. Finally, he walked the Board through the percentage weights for TERS' largest investment managers and reviewed recent steps to further diversify these exposures.

Cyber Security

Chief Investment Officer Tim Atwill discussed a recent cyber security incident that impacted several U.S. public pension plans. He then went on to report on the results of the inquiry sent to TERS' asset managers and partners: TERS' information was not at risk in this incident.

New Business

TERS, SERS and SCERS

Retirement Director Tim Allen presented a comparison of the public pension plans of the three first class cities in Washington State: Seattle, Spokane and Tacoma. He discussed some key differences in terms of membership, investment performance and funded status.

Retirement Director's Report

Retirement Director Tim Allen reported that TERS' projected fair value funded ratio had likely declined in October, falling to just over 91%. He discussed possible reconfigurations of the Retirement Department's office space, noted an upcoming Retirement Planning Session, and provided an update on staffing.

Retirement Transactions Report – August and September 2023

The Retirement Transactions Report for August and September 2023 was provided electronically to the Board in the Board Packet.

Summary Annual Financial Report 2022

The new design for TERS' Summary Annual Financial Report (SAFR) was presented.

The Retirement Director discussed Milliman's proposed schedule of actuarial tasks to be performed on behalf of TERS in 2024.
