### **To local resident or business owner:**

This notice is to inform you of a pending application for a Special Event Permit which will impact roads and/or other public right-of-way in your neighborhood. Closing roads during this event is required for the greatest public safety. Efforts will be made to minimize the impact to your residence or business. Event coordinators are required to instruct participants to follow all applicable City, State and Federal laws. Access to private driveways, parking lots/garages, sidewalks, walkways and/or alley ways may be delayed during the event; emergency vehicles will always have access to roads. This letter has been mailed to the general surrounding area as part of our public notification process. Please feel free to share with others in your neighborhood.

### **ROAD CLOSURE IMPACTS AND EVENT INFORMATION**

The Proctor Tacoma Criterium event will take place on Sunday, June 24, 2018 and involves road closures on N 26<sup>th</sup>, N 27<sup>th</sup>, N Madison, and N Washington streets, and on N Proctor and N Adams. Closures will begin as early as 6:00 AM and will reopen at approximately 10:00 PM. Temporary "no parking" signs will be posted alongside the streets announcing the dates and times that no parking will be enforced. Vehicles must be moved by the time indicated or drivers may receive a citation and their vehicle may be towed and impounded. A map of the closure and associated signage is on the back of this letter.

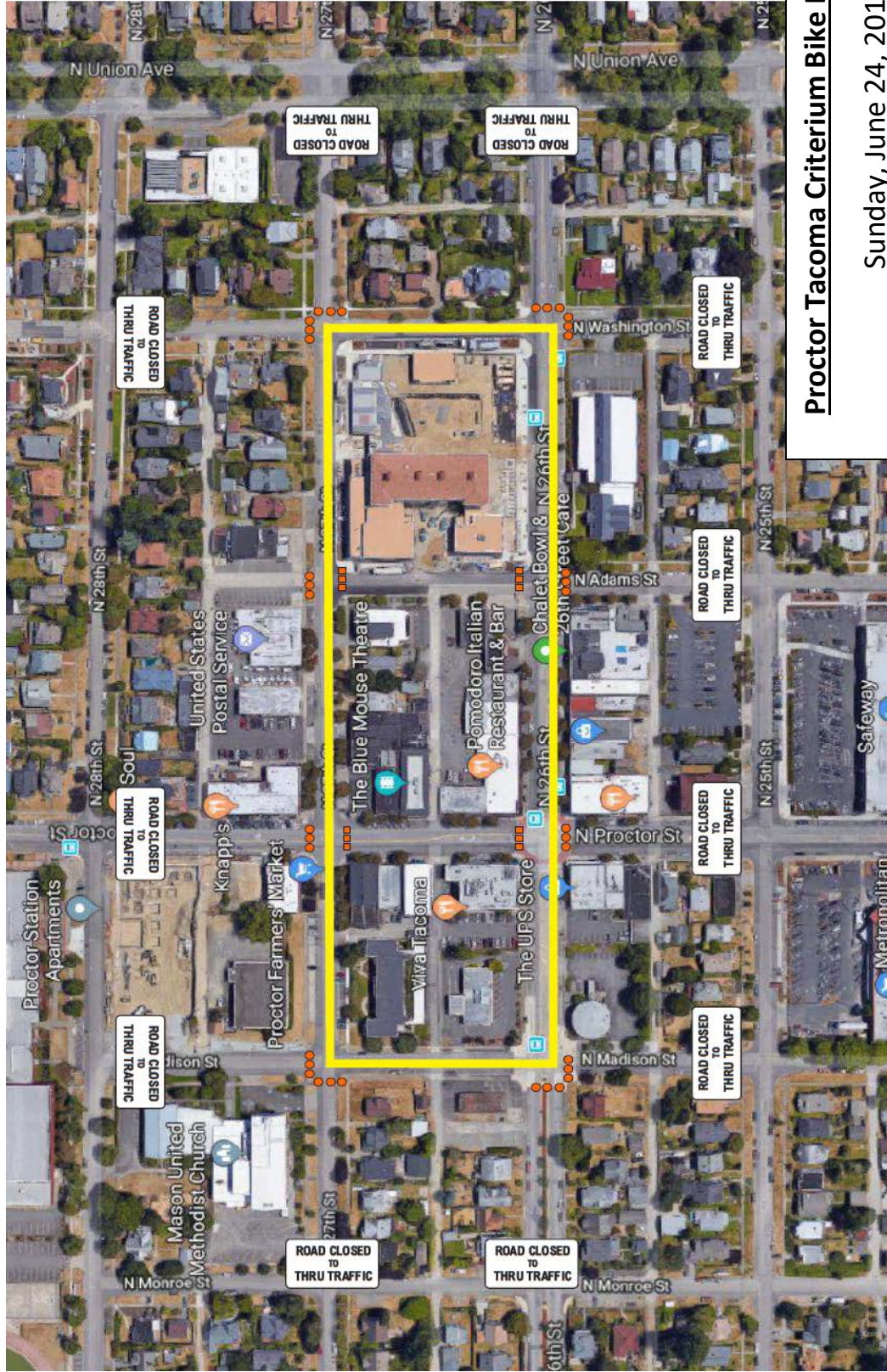
