To local resident or business owner:

This notice is to inform you of a pending application for a Special Event Permit which will impact roads and/or other public right-of-way in your neighborhood. Closing the road during this event is required for the greatest public safety. Efforts will be made to minimize the impact to your residence or business. Event coordinators are required to instruct participants to follow all applicable City, State and Federal laws. Access to private driveways, parking lots/garages, sidewalks, walkways and/or alley ways may be delayed during the event; emergency vehicles will always have access to roads. This letter has been mailed to the general surrounding area as part of our public notification process. Please feel free to share with others in your neighborhood.

ROAD CLOSURE IMPACTS AND EVENT INFORMATION

The **South Sound Heart and Stroke Walk** event will take place on Saturday, September 22, 2018 and may impact vehicular traffic along S 19th and S Tyler streets. Activity may begin as early as 6:00 AM and will cease at approximately 1:00 PM. Tacoma Police Officers will monitor both vehicular and pedestrian traffic, and will temporarily halt traffic if needed. Bus stops will remain open in the area. For details, see the diagram on the back of this notice.
