Subject: Special Event No. 18-0106 St. Paddy's Day Run Tacoma

Permission is hereby granted to Tacoma City Marathon Association for the Annual St. Paddy's Day Run on Saturday, March 16, 2019 with road closures on Pacific Ave, north of South 8th St., Schuster Parkway, and Ruston Way—all will have full or partial closures – see attached traffic control plan for details. Closures will begin as early as 5:30 AM and will reopen at approximately 1:00 PM, or earlier. Marked detours will be in place.

Permit Number 18-0106 is issued contingent upon the following conditions:

- 1. Permit holder shall <u>arrange a meeting immediately with Special Events Sgt. Gary Roberts</u> if there are changes from the approved permit; Sgt. Roberts can be reached at (253) 405-9056. The Police Department recommends approval of this permit with the following stipulations.
 - a. You have arranged for and agree to pay for police services with Sgt. Roberts.
 - b. Permit holder will notify all participants to obey all City of Tacoma; Pierce County Washington State and Federal rules, regulations, and laws.
 - c. Sponsor will maintain public and participant safety at all times and adhere to traffic lights and crosswalk rules.
- 2. The Traffic Engineering Division has reviewed the Special Event Permit Application and has no objections.
 - a. You have provided a final traffic control plan to the Traffic Engineering Division and it has been approved.
 - b. You are responsible for obtaining, paying for, placing and removing traffic control devices required by the approved traffic control plan from a private company.
 - c. You are responsible for notifying all appropriate public entities regarding your road closure.
 - d. Remember to maintain at the least, a 6-foot, unobstructed pedestrian right-of-way and handicapped access through the event area at all times.
 - e. For questions relating to this section Tyler Daniels, Public Works Traffic Engineering, can be reached at (253) 591-5554.
- 3. The Fire Department has reviewed the application and has no objections. Additional conditions are:
 - a. If applicable you have applied for and received permits associated with the Tacoma Fire Department's requirements for Special Events.
 - b. Emergency vehicle access will be allowed for the entire extent of the event venue. The following things must remain visible, and the path to them must remain unobstructed.
 - c. Fire hydrants, Sprinkler connections, Standpipe connections, Fire alarm boxes, Building entrances, Exit doors, Aisles, Exit lights, Stairways, Hose cabinets, Fire extinguishers, and any other Emergency equipment.
 - d. Questions about fire regulations and permits can be directed to Lt. Ken Hansen at (253) 591-5762.
- 4. In regard to noise levels, the event shall comply the following provisions:
 - a. Limit the decibel level of sound at the event border line to a maximum of 85 dBA at receiving residential properties. This restriction is consistent with Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 173-60-050 for public special events.

- 5. Surrounding businesses and residents have been notified of the event activity, its impact to parking, pedestrian traffic, etc., and have made no objections to the event activity.
- 6. That you have this permit letter readily available during the event, and shall present this permit upon demand of any City official.

Failure to comply with any of these requirements constitutes a violation of the permit as granted and the event may be terminated by the permitting authority or her designee. Noncompliance may also jeopardize the approval of future events.

This permit is granted subject to all other applicable laws and ordinances. This permit does not constitute a waiver by the City of any laws or ordinances that may apply to the permitted event or any activities associated with the permitted event. Typical Road Closure


Length road closure and all it's tributaries on Pacific Ave from So. 9th St to Schuster Pkwy then on to Ruston wy up to N Waterview St.
