Dear Tacoma Business Owner or Resident,

The City of Tacoma's Special Events Office has received an application to permit Eastside Families Back to School Parade on Thursday, August 28, 2014. This letter is to inform you of police escorted rolling road closures during this event starting at the community park on E 39th Street. Road closures will be from approximately 11:00 AM and will reopen as the parade passes. For details see the diagram on the back of this letter.

Rolling road closures during this event is required for the greatest public safety. Every effort will be made to minimize the impact to your residence or business. Event coordinators are required to instruct participants to follow all applicable City, State and Federal laws. Access to private driveways, parking lots/garages, sidewalks, walkways and/or alley ways may be delayed during the event. Emergency vehicles will always have access during events.

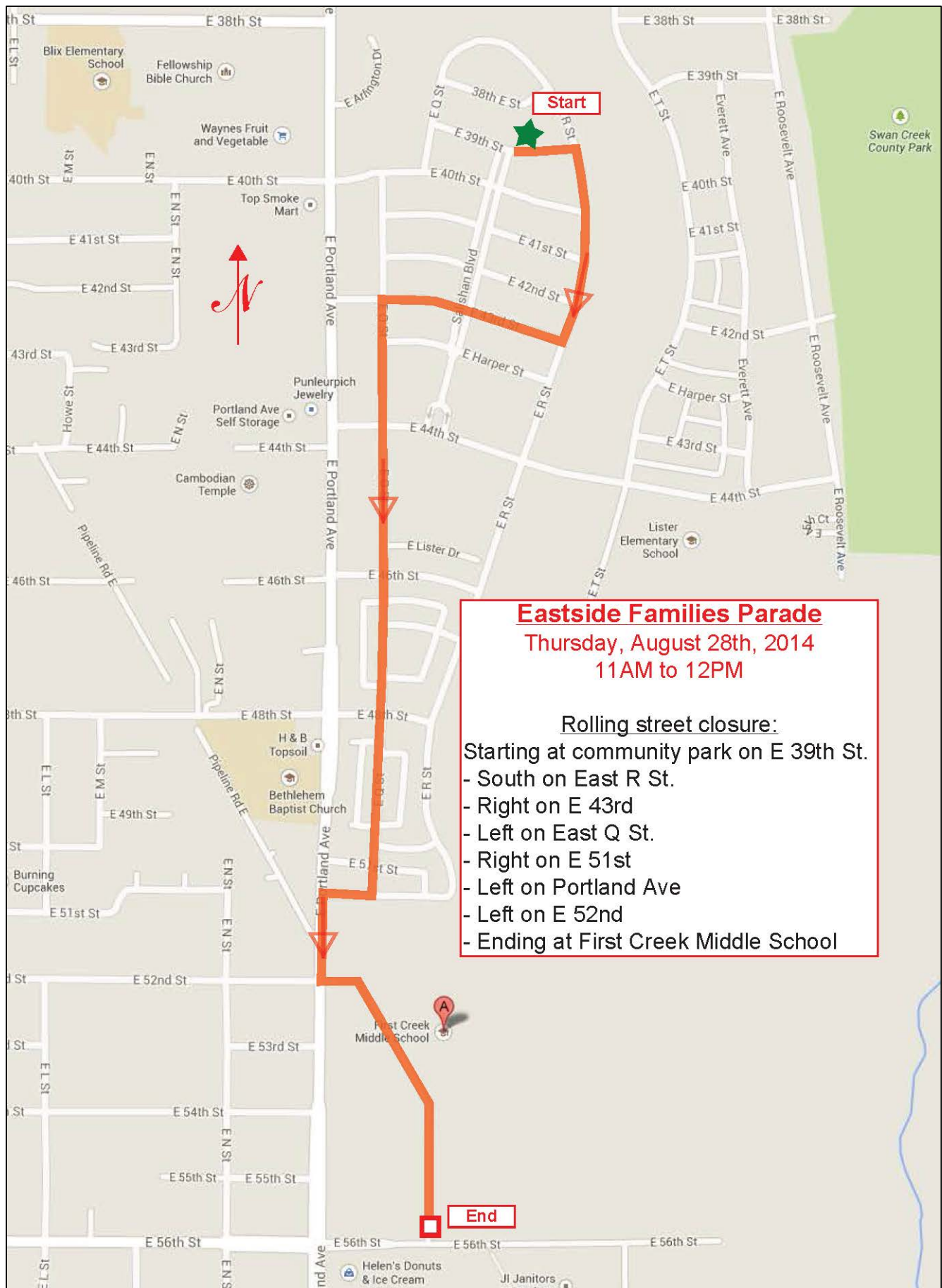
