The police-escorted rolling closure will take place from 10:00 AM until 2:00 PM on Martin Luther King Jr. Way from MLK Jr. Way & 23<sup>rd</sup> to Peoples Park (MLK Jr. Way & S 9<sup>th</sup> St).
