The City of Tacoma's Special Events Office has received an application to permit the annual South Sound AIDS Walk. This letter is to inform you of heightened pedestrian activity during this event on Saturday, September 20, 2014. The fundraising walk will take place from 9:00 AM until 2:00 PM. Participants will start and end at Cheney Stadium, and will walk on the Scott Pierson Trail, and sidewalks on South 19th and Tyler. For details see the diagram on the back of this letter.
